- ◆ The County will hold its 7th annual Elder Safety Event in conjunction with “World Elder Abuse Awareness Week,” June 12-17, 2017.
- ◆ This year’s theme will feature Senior Safety in Age-Friendly Montgomery County.
- ◆ The purpose of the forum is to educate our community; including older adults, family members, and professionals on the presence of elder abuse, the warning signs, and who to turn to for help.
- ◆ Representatives and exhibitors from organizations that assist seniors will be on hand to provide information. Many of these organizations play a direct role in helping seniors reduce their vulnerability to abuse and keeping seniors safe.
- ◆ It is hosted by public agencies who protect the County’s seniors: the Montgomery County Police Department, the Ombudsman Program, Adult Protective Services, Licensure and Regulatory Services, the State’s Attorney’s Office, the Office of the County Attorney and Fire and Rescue Service. Partners include: the City of Rockville Department of Recreation & Parks, ElderSAFE Center, and Charles E. Smith Life Communities.
